MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief,
SUBJECT : Project Review - OFTEN

In OFTEN Project Review held 30 November 1966 the following points were brought out:

1. [redacted] have been approached. Eight companies have been left drafts of our contractual agreements, these are [redacted] [redacted] have responded.
2. Companies that are yet to be approached include [redacted]
3. There are reasons for which I would not wish to approach [redacted] personally but would prefer Dr. [redacted] to do so.
4. In addition, it would be helpful for Dr. [redacted] to assist in visits to drug companies in Philadelphia and the New York area.
5. Eleven compound samples have been received and turned over to [redacted] Labs. These are [redacted]
6. [redacted] is in the process of developing various Behavioral Screens. It was agreed to hold any sample screening in abeyance until the screening methods have been fully developed. Dr. [redacted] will consult with [redacted] on Behavioral tests.
7. An [redacted] panel will be established, including members of [redacted] as observers, for the purpose of selecting compounds to be submitted to [redacted]
8. Emphasis will be placed on compounds affecting motivation, judgment and emotions.
